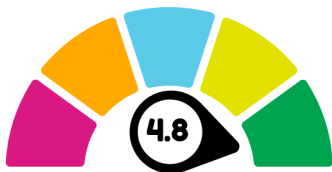

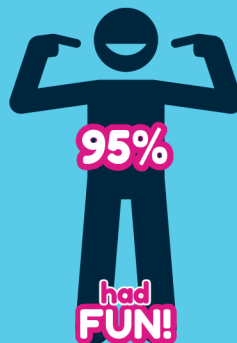
ICT performs extensive evaluation of Tennis in the Parks. In 2026 staff personally interviewed 123 youth participants and received surveys from 94 parents/guardians.
